<p>Eva has a red and swollen outer ear. Her doctor examines it with an otoscope.</p>	<p>Bob is very dizzy and is having trouble with his balance. He also has a severe ringing in his ear.</p>	<p>Lara pushed a Q-tip too far into her ear. Her doctor uses an otoscope to look in her ear and sees a small tear on her tympanic membrane (eardrum)</p>
<p>Chris has an abnormally small pinna. This type of condition can cause him to have hearing loss.</p>	<p>Sammy has episodes of dizziness followed by nausea and vomiting. He also has experienced episodes of hearing loss.</p>	<p>Burt has been having difficulty hearing, so he goes to the doctor. His doctor looks into his ear and sees a lot of earwax.</p>
<p>Shelly has been experiencing dizziness, balance issues, and facial weakness and numbness.</p>	<p>Barry has been experiencing muffled hearing as well as pressure on the sides of his neck.</p>	<p>Kira has been experiencing ear pain. She goes to her doctor and he tells her that her eardrum is red and swollen.</p>
